



# Governor's Community Corrections Award 2006

## Purpose

To recognize the exceptional contribution of an individual to public safety in the arena of community corrections.

## Rationale

The commitment of many individuals to community corrections extends far beyond the traditional professional or citizen roles in government, board membership, service providers and staff. The intent of this award is to highlight an individual's significant contribution to community corrections by a single or unique act or service, a continuing contribution, or a development or an innovation that may have improved services in this arena.

## Criteria

To be eligible for this award, the nominee should be a community corrections board member; a staff member to a community corrections board; a staff member of the State of Colorado Department of Corrections Division of Community Corrections and Adult Parole or Department of Public Safety Division of Criminal Justice or Judicial Department; a staff member of a community corrections service provider; or a citizen of the Colorado community at large.

## Nomination Process

Any member of the community may nominate the individual whose service meets the intent and criteria of the award. A completed nomination form and a letter, brochure, newspaper article, or other description of the innovation, contribution or program in which the nominee is involved must be submitted. The award may be bestowed yearly if eligible candidates are nominated or deemed worthy by the Award Committee. Members of the Award Committee will review all nominations.
