Position Statement – 05-23-06
Requirements for Individuals Working Towards Listing Status

Adult Standards Reference:

Adult Standards 4.110 – Providers who are approved at the Full Operating Level and wish to supervise Associate Level Treatment Providers or *individuals who have not applied* (italics added), but are earning their clinical hours, shall submit to the Board supervision agreements with all individuals that they supervise within 30 days from the time the supervision begins.

Position Statement:

The Sex Offender Management Board (SOMB) requirements currently dictate that a treatment provider work towards listing status by completing required competencies in the areas of clinical experience, supervision, and training, among others. The SOMB has identified clinical contact requirements, some of which must occur in co-therapy with a full operating listed treatment provider and some of which do not have such a requirement. The SOMB recognizes the need for treatment providers to meet these qualifications for listed provider status prior to actually receiving such status. It is, therefore, the position of the SOMB that a treatment provider under the supervision of a full operating listed treatment provider may provide treatment services without such a supervisor in the room during the course of some of their clinical contacts, while working towards listing status, provided they are also working towards meeting the requirement for co-facilitated clinical contact as well. It is incumbent upon the clinical supervisor to determine the appropriate time to move their supervisee from exclusively co-facilitated clinical contact to partial non-co-facilitated clinical contact based upon that individual's progress in attaining competency to perform such treatment. The Standards hold the full operating level listed supervisor responsible for all clinical work performed by the supervisee.
