Dear DVOMB Approved Treatment Provider,

The DVOMB, through the Division of Criminal Justice, has implemented a Listserv for DVOMB Approved Treatment Providers. (A listserv is a system designed to simplify the process of sending the same message to a group of people via email. The email is sent to the List's email address, and the List distributes the message to everyone who is subscribed to the mailing list.)

The ListServ provides a way to pose questions, provide information, and have discussions regarding current topics related to DV offender treatment in Colorado.

If you are interested in subscribing to the DVOMB Approved Treatment Provider Listserv (dvombtx), please follow the instructions below.

1. To sign up, **click on "ListServ link" found directly under "ListServ instructions"**.

You may subscribe to the ListServ by following the instructions in this link.

2. After signing up, you will receive an email that states "Your subscription request has been received and will soon be acted upon." The List Administrator, Zoe Henry, will verify that you are an approved provider. Within one to five days, you will receive a welcome message from the DVOMB containing instructions and rules for use of the Listserv.
3. Print a copy of the message for future reference for it details how to post to the list, general information about the list, and how to unsubscribe or change your options.
4. To post a message on the Listserv, send an email message to dvombtx@cdps-l.state.co.us [The l is a lowercase letter l]
5. Only DVOMB Approved Treatment Providers may be on this ListServ.

Hopefully, you will take this opportunity to connect with other providers, as well as have greater input into the work of the DVOMB Board.
