Reapplication Policy Addendum

Regarding Approved Providers who are “Not Currently Practicing”

Definition: Not Currently Practicing means not providing any court ordered domestic violence offender treatment, including not performing evaluations and not providing peer consultation or clinical supervision.

- A. A Provider can choose whether or not they wish to classify himself/herself as “Not Currently Practicing”.
- B. Once a Provider identifies himself/herself as “Not Currently Practicing”, he/she may remain on the Approved Provider List with the following conditions:
- C. The Provider shall notify the DVOMB office in writing that they are “Not Currently Practicing”.
 1. The Approved Provider List will reflect this as follows:
 - a. The Provider will be listed only in the alphabetical section and will be identified in that listing as “Not Currently Practicing”. No contact information (phone, address, etc) will be listed.
 - b. The Provider will not be listed on any county, districts, or specialty lists.
 2. The Provider **WILL BE** required to participate in the Biennial Renewal Process
 3. Continuing education requirements continue to apply per the *Standards*.
- D. Before the Provider can begin practicing again:
 1. He/she shall notify the DVOMB office, in writing, of the date that he/she will resume providing domestic violence offender treatment.
 2. Once the Provider’s letter is received, the DVOMB office will send the Provider a confirmation letter. The DVOMB office will also determine when the most recent Reapplication or original Application of the Provider was reviewed and approved. If the Provider has not completed a new Application or Reapplication review process in the previous three years, then he/she will be mailed a Reapplication packet that the Provider will be required to submit within six months.
 3. Providers will also be required to submit all continuing education certificates, as required in the Standards, for the time period since their last Application or Reapplication.
