The Family Center provides Approved Supervision Training on an individualized and/or group basis. This training is available to supporters of post-conviction adult sex offenders who have been approved to have contact with specific children via PRA evaluation. It is also available to supporters of adult sex offenders involved in offense-specific treatment, who anticipate contact with specific children and/or expect to have contact in approved public places with children in the future. Treatment provider(s) conducting Approved Supervision Training from The Family Center each have 20+ years experience working with sex offenders, their families, and victims. The Approved Supervision Training presented by The Family Center complies with requirements of the Sex Offender Management Board Standards.

CURRICULUM WILL ADDRESS:

****Qualifications of Approved Supervisor** (in accordance with SOMB standard 5.761)

****Review of required information to be disclosed to Approved Supervisor** (in accordance with SOMB standard 5.762), to include, but not limited to: factual basis of offender's crime of conviction; assessment of risk; deviant sexual arousal patterns; offense cycle; grooming behavior; probation and treatment rules and requirements; philosophy of offense-specific (victim-centered) treatment.

****Duties and Responsibilities of Approved Supervisor** (in accordance with SOMB standard 5.763)

****Review of Family Rules of Contact**

****Development of a Written Safety Plan and Statement of Responsibility**, to be approved by the Offender, Informed Supervisor, and members of the Community Supervision Team. **Depending** on the needs of the Offender, Approved Supervisor, and at the request of the Community Supervision Team, The Family Center is also prepared to provide extensive Relapse Prevention Training and ongoing Approved Supervisor support. For those Offenders requesting contact with specific children outside their immediate family, and/or have not passed a PRA polygraph, additional sessions will be indicated after the Offender has verified the accuracy of his Sexual History document by Sexual History Polygraph. This will allowed Approved Supervisors to receive additional training in order to become an approved Chaperone for the Offender. The Family Center is also prepared to provide supervised contact between an Offender and minor children, as appropriate.

Length of Training: Approximately 8 hours, depending on needs of the Approved Supervisor, Offender and at the request of the Community Supervision Team.

Cost: May vary, depending on the modality of service provided, urgency of completion of training, and availability of other clients to complete curriculum in a group setting. No more than \$50.00/hour, not to exceed \$300.00 for entire 8-hour training.
