

**Sex Offender Management Board's
Best Practices Committee
Statement of Status on Savio House's MST-PSB Program
UPDATED JULY 28, 2010**

The Sex Offender Management Board (SOMB) recently removed the Variance that had been granted to Savio House's MST-PSB Program for Juveniles Who Have Committed Sexual Offenses. It was determined that a variance was no longer needed and felt that the Savio MST-PSB therapists were acting in accordance to the *Standards*. It should be noted that Savio MST-PSB is a stand-alone modality for juveniles who have committed sexual offenses. Unless recommended by the MDT, no adjunct services are needed for juveniles receiving MST-PSB services.

The Best Practices Committee, along with the Application Review Committee will be developing a mechanism by which individuals certified as MST-PSB providers can become listed in the same way that Associate and Full Operating Level Treatment Providers are currently listed. Individuals employed with Savio House will remain on the Savio House MST-PSB list until further notice.
